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FINNISH NURSE

UNIFORM CODE

- Legislation behind the code
- Employer provides uniform to staff members and students, also takes care of the maintenance like washing the uniform (hospitals, elderly care homes)
 - Professional cleaning of uniform increases hygiene
- Must be comfortable, professional and suitable for job done
- Employer can choose their own uniform (style, colour etc.)
- We don't use any other accessories
- ID- band must be worn at all the times

APPEARANCE OF THE NURSE

- Short nails
- No nailpolish, artificial nails, piercing
- No ring, watch, bracelet,
- No hanging ear rings
- No perfume, aftershave
- Visible tattoos and dreadlocks are allowed
- Hair must be tied



WORKING SHOES

- Employee provides themselves- tax deductible
- Comfortable, unslippery, sturdy,
- Easy to clean, breathable, backstrap or Closed shoes



SALARY

- Normally student doesn't get paid during their practice, however
- Student on employer can have a contract of employment and student gets salary
- Also apprenticeship is possible
- Practical nurse average salary is 1900-2000€
- Average salary in Finland is 3300€



REPORTING

- Schools can decide if student have any paperwork/reports to be done during practical training.
- Students write report to patient documents what they have done with him/her and also observations they have done (Staff member will check the notes)

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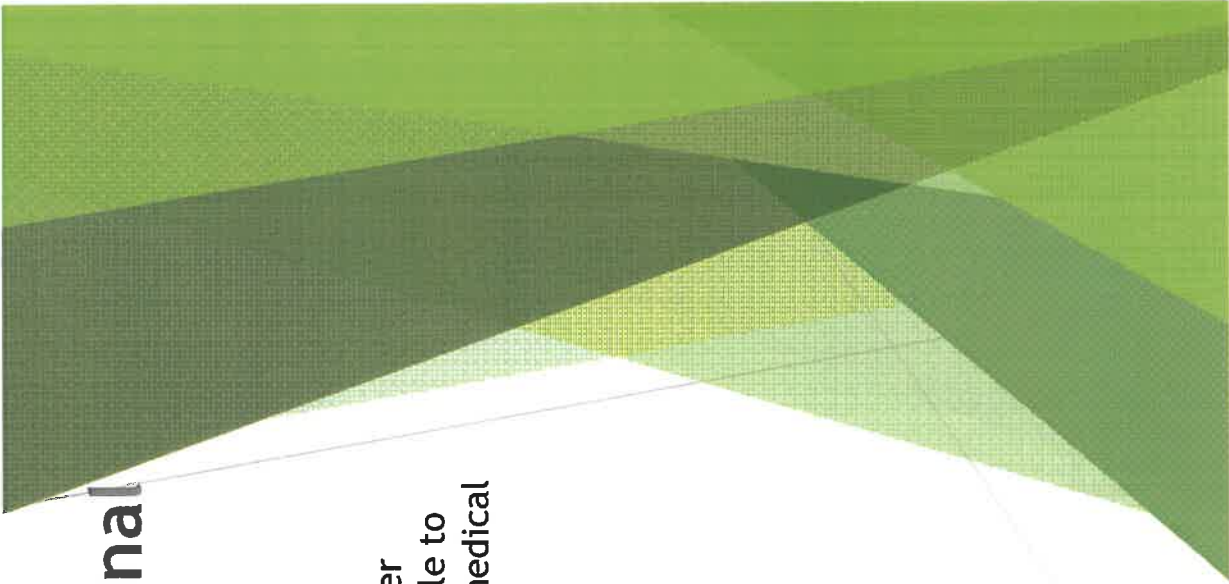

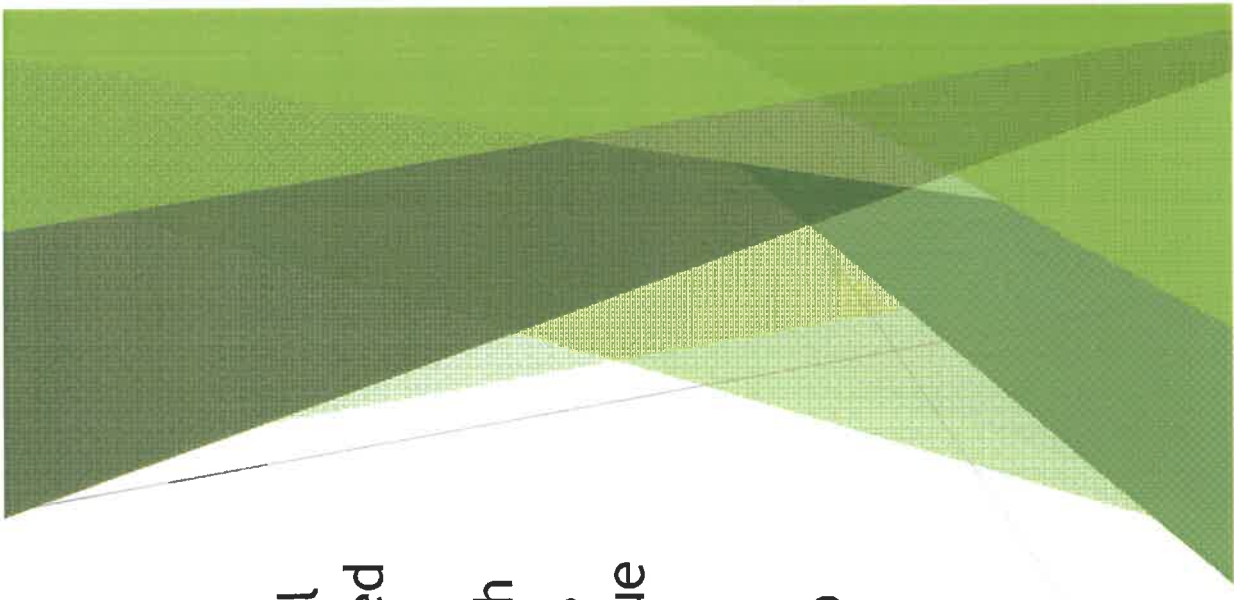


▲ On this photo there are nurses from Skopje General Hospital. This photo was taken in Skopje. The uniform was composed of:

Uniforms Now

Now, nurses in our hospital are wearing uniforms called scrubs. They include short-sleeve shirt or waist-length long-sleeved jacket, pants and clogs. Nurses wear blue scrubs because it is soothing, relaxing, and calming like green it also lowers blood pressure and eases anxiety.

Paramedics are wearing grey scrubs.



Surgeons are wearing green scrubs because green lowers down the high blood pressure and gives the eyes rest.



Doctors are wearing white coats because white represents purity, honesty and cleanliness.

- ▶ As students having practice in hospital, our uniforms are white. We buy them and take care of them at home. Few years ago, our uniform included a mob-cap, coat, skirt and clogs. Now the skirts are replaced with pants.

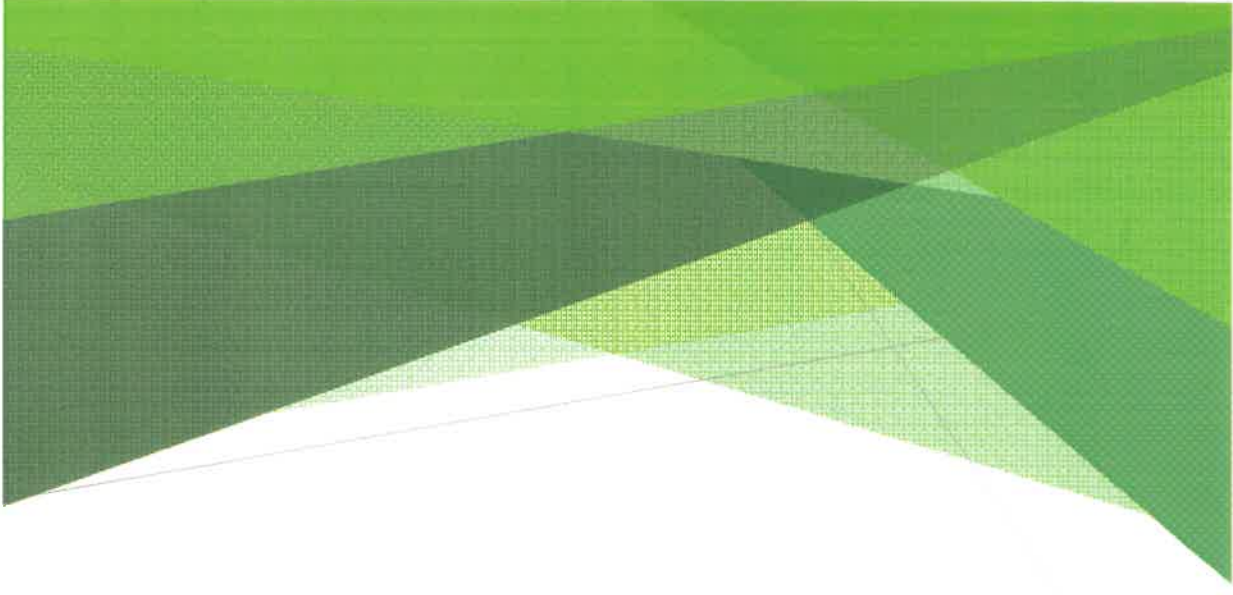

What kind of uniforms are worn by nursing assistants?

Nursing assistants generally use what is known here as a white pajamas. It is composed of a white shirt and white pants.

We wear comfortable shoes, such as clogs or sneakers, everything white.



Our uniform

In Spain, students buy their uniforms. Normally the students have 2 or 3. The nursing assistants in practices have to wash their uniform at home.

You can't normally wear jewellery by hygienic measures. Small earrings are sometimes allowed.

Employees can wear visible tattoos and dreadlocks that like any hairstyle should be picked up. We can't wear false or long nails.

- **Prepare the material needed to perform the cures**



The salary

The average salary of Spanish people is around **1400 euros** per month.

The average wage for nurses is **1100 euros** per month.

- We would improve some safety measures at work and protective equipment.
 - Dedicate a subject to ergonomics and correct postures.
 - Students would have to have the conditions of a worker.
 - They should wash the uniform in the hospital, these should not cost you and paid practices.
